



Bash Racing Instructions

1. The racecourse start line will be $\frac{1}{2}$ mile due west of the dam and marina, running parallel to the dam. Two yellow cylinders will be the marks. Head through the marks from east to west when the start horn goes off at 10:00 am sharp.
2. There will be two yellow cylinder marks for the short turnaround and long turnaround. The short turnaround mark will be approximately straight south of the Boy Scout Camp near center of lake, and the long turnaround mark will be approximately straight south of the Colony, near the center of the lake. Monitor channel 69 on VHF for instructions on which mark to round to port before the return to the start finish line. Distance is approximately 5 miles to the scout camp, and 10 miles to the colony turnaround.



Starting Sequence

0955 AM – White Class Flag Raises with a horn audible

0956 AM – Blue with White square “P” flag raises with horn audible

0959 AM - Blue with White square “P” flag drops with horn audible

1000 AM - White Class Flag drops with horn audible, and the race is STARTED!

Beach Cat Class - countdown starts at 1025 am with 1030 am start

3. Continue to monitor channel 69 throughout the race for updates from the race committee. We will monitor the weather and should the race course need to be shortened or abandoned you will be notified on VHF 69. Should any vessel need assistance during the race hail race committee on channel 69. There will be two large power boats out on the water with functions as race committee and safety.
4. Hail Race committee on VHF 69 as you cross finish line to help them identify your boat.
